Christ the King Bereavement & Support Group

The Bereavement and Support Services team celebrated its fourth anniversary on 14th June. At present membership of this group stands at twenty five and five persons are awaiting certification.

What role does the group play in the church?

It was formed to provide support to persons suffering loss of any kind. It is not limited to those bereaved by death, but extends to sickness, loss of job, limbs, mobility etc.

What are the typical activities of such a role?

Support activities are on two levels emotional and spiritual. These include conversing with and listening to the bereaved, home visits, making telephone calls and attending funerals.

Is there specific training done to equip members for this important ministry?

Training is done by the National Assistance Board. Our relationship with other churches of the Diocese and other organisations, further avails us to continuous training via lectures, seminars etc.

Do members provide counselling?

No. Members are not trained counsellors. They advise the bereaved to seek professional help if the occasion merits it.

If you wish to be a part of this team, please contact the Coordinator Mrs. Joycelin Farley who will brief you on the requirements.

God, the Father

Fathers' Day calls us to reflect on what it means to call God "Father". The use of the father analogy can be wonderfully comforting for those who have had good relationships with their earthly fathers or father-figures or it can instil a sense of dread in those who have not been so lucky.

However, this is an unfortunate consequence of our human nature. As seen in both the Nicene and Apostles' Creed, the fatherly role of God is intrinsically linked with His creative role. God as father implies that He is the origin and authority, of all but even more that He cares for the needs of all. To call God "Father" means that He is near to us, intimately concerned with us and knows us intimately. As the psalmist puts it, "For it was you who formed my inward parts; you knit me together in my mother's womb". Through the scriptures we also come to an understanding of God the father as a forgiving and ever-merciful Being.

The challenge for fathers is to interact with their children in such a way as to bring honour to the title "Father" and when in need to guidance, they need only look to our Heavenly Father.
