# *Saints' Days*

## *Benedict of Nursia*

*On July 11<sup>th</sup>, the Anglican Communion remembers Benedict of Nursia. Benedict founded the abbey which stands to this day as the head of the worldwide Benedictine Order. He drew up the rule of life for monks, that focused on obedience and humility.*

## *St. Silas*

*One of the leading members of the early Christian community, Silas would accompany St. Paul on two of his missionary journeys. The Acts of the Apostles records that Silas was with Paul in Philippi where they were imprisoned but freed when an earthquake broke their chains and opened the prison doors. He is thus sometimes portrayed as carrying broken chains. St. Silas is commemorated on July 13<sup>th</sup>.*

## **SERMON NOTES**

## ***Recommended Reading***

**The Cost of Discipleship** is a book by the German theologian Dietrich Bonhoeffer. It is considered a classic of Christian thought and is centered on an exposition of the Sermon on the Mount. In his work, Bonhoeffer spells out what he believes it means to follow Christ. One of the most quoted parts of the book deals with the distinction between what he calls “cheap” and “costly” grace. In Bonhoeffer’s words: ***“cheap grace is the preaching of forgiveness without requiring repentance, baptism without church discipline. Communion without confession. Cheap grace is grace without discipleship, grace without the cross, grace without Jesus Christ.”***
