SERMON NOTES

Saints' Days

St. Mary Magdalene: As one of the important early Disciples of Christ, Mary Magdalene was the first person to see the risen Christ. She has been called the second most important woman in the New Testament after Mary, the mother of Jesus. This year, the feast of St. Mary Magdalene is commemorated on July 22nd.

St. James the Apostle: James was one of the first apostles of Jesus and one of the three Apostles to witness the Transfiguration. Tradition holds that he was martyred by King Herod. The feast of St. James the Apostle is celebrated on July 25th.

St. Christopher: Known as the "Christ bearer", St. Christopher is the patron saint of travellers. Historians believe that he may have been martyred in the 3rd century under Emperor Decius or Dacian. St. Christopher is remembered on July 25th.

Thomas à Kempis: Thomas à Kempis was a priest, copyist and writer. He copied the Bible no fewer than four times and is the most probable author of "The Imitation of Christ", which is one of the best known Christian books on devotion. Thomas à Kempis is remembered on July 24th.

Joachim and Anne, Parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary: Neither St. Anne nor St. Joachim is mentioned in the New Testament writing and all we know about them is found in apocryphal writings. They are commemorated together on July 26th.

VBS - Welcome to Promise Land

Each adventure was explored through the study of the relevant bible text and enforced by a memory verse, drama, story, art and craft. The sessions ran from 9.00 am to 3.00 pm daily and were filled with activities most of which related to the central themes.

During the daily break the children made full use of the play park and surrounding facilities by playing games and socialising. Fellowship was further enhanced at a picnic and fun day at King George V Memorial Park last Wednesday. Although the Fun Day segment was affected by the showers and had to be eliminated, the children enjoyed the outing.

The Adventure ended on Friday 19th with an Open Day which gave the parents an opportunity to view the art and craft done by the children.

We commend Mrs. Wendy Howard, Mrs. Lisa Gaskin and the entire planning team; teachers and helpers who ensured the children were taught, fed and supervised continuously as well as all the sponsors for another successful year of Vacation Bible School.
