Holy Days

***The Presentation of Our Lord:** This feast day is also known as the Feast of the Purification of the Virgin, or Candlemas Day. According to St. Luke's gospel, Mary and Joseph took the infant Jesus to the Temple in Jerusalem 40 days after his birth to complete Mary's ritual purification and to perform the redemption of the firstborn, in compliance with Jewish Law. The feast day of the Presentation of Our Lord in the Temple is celebrated today, February 2nd.*

Saints Days

***Anskar, Archbishop:** Anskar was a monk and later archbishop in the 9th century, who was a missionary to Denmark and Sweden. The Church of Sweden honours him as its apostle and he serves as a symbol of the historic friendship and connection between the Anglican Church and the Church of Sweden to this day. Anskar is remembered on February 3rd.*

***Cornelius, the Centurion:** Cornelius was a Roman centurion who is considered to be the first Gentile to convert to the Christian faith. The baptism of Cornelius was a significant event in the history of the early Church, since it showed that salvation was available to all without having to submit to Jewish laws. The feast day of St. Cornelius is commemorated on February 4th.*

***Martyrs of Japan:** There were Christians in Japan in the 17th century who were persecuted for their faith. These were Christians who were persecuted for their faith in Japan, mostly during the 17th century. It is not known exactly how many persons were executed. The martyrs are collectively remembered on February 5th.*

Your Anglican Heritage

The Nunc Dimittis: The Nunc Dimittis, also known as the Song of Simeon, is a canticle or hymn of praise based on Luke 2:29-32. It is called the Nunc Dimittis for its first words in Latin.

Because of its implications of fulfilment, peace and rest, the Church views it as appropriate for the ending of the day. Since the 4th century it has been used for evening worship such as Compline, Vespers and Evensong.
