Saints Days

Cyril and Methodius: Saints Cyril and Methodius are brothers born in Thessalonica in the 9th century, who became missionaries among the Slavic people. Through their work, they influenced the cultural development of all Slavs. The feast day of Cyril and Methodius is commemorated on February 14th.

Finding Joy in the Midst of Life's Struggles

I have a friend who loves to say ‘Don’t let anyone steal your joy’. In these challenging times, we can rephrase that and say ‘We will not let anyone or anything steal our joy’. As Christians, this should not just be an empty saying but must be how we live our lives.

Unfortunately, many persons believe that as Christians we should not have to endure any hardships. But nothing can be further from the truth. Over and over again, the scriptures tell us that we ought to expect trouble. We are told in John 16:33 that Jesus told his followers that they will face tribulations. Indeed, the writer of James 1:2-4 tells us that we ought to consider it joy when we face trials of any kind. **But how is that possible?**

The answer is clear if we look at John 16:33 closely. The full text says “I have said this to you, so that *in me* you may have peace. In the world you face persecution. But take courage; *I have conquered the world!*” Thus, we see that it is through Christ that we can rejoice in the middle of any troubles. He has provided us with hope – not in the modern wishy-washy sense but in the biblical sense that speak to a sense of confidence and assurance. Throughout the scriptures, from the Old Testament to Revelations, we see persons who have found joy in their troubles because they recognize that because God is their salvation, they can trust and not be afraid.

So, encourage one another. Hold firm to the God-given hope that is ours.

DO NOT LET ANYONE OR ANYTHING STEAL YOUR JOY!

THE FRIDAY SCHOOL

The Friday School was established in Eden Lodge, St. Michael on February 16, 1990. As a Christian and ardent church-goer, it weighed heavily on Mrs. Mavis Browne's mind that there was no spiritual guidance among the youth of the Eden Lodge area and that many of the children did not attend Church or Sunday School. Mrs. Browne decided to personally invite parents to Church and offered to take responsibility for the children that could not attend services. She discovered that many parents could not afford the clothes and other necessities for their children to attend church.

Mrs. Browne remembered her own humble upbringing when persons reached out to her and others by "gathering", the children as it was then called to a central point in the village. In this "gathering" two persons conducted what was called a "children's outdoor church" or Sunday School. Mrs. Browne felt that God was asking her to reach out to the Eden Lodge community, especially to the children. She discussed her thoughts of establishing a children's outdoor church in her home with the former Rector of the

Church of Christ the King, Rev. Eric Lynch, her husband Bertram Browne and Sister Valentine Green, a member of the church. They willingly and enthusiastically assisted and the programme continued for more than 20 years.

Despite the pains and discomfort during her illness in 2013, Mrs. Browne was worried about the future of the Friday School as her thoughts were always on the young ones and what would happen to them in the event of her death. On January 30, 2013 Mrs. Mavis Browne was called to rest. Her husband Bertram Browne passed away eight years earlier and Sister Valentine Green also predeceased her. Despite her death, the children from the area would still congregate at the "Brownes" home on Friday evenings. In addition many of the parents/guardians in Eden Lodge, along with members of the Church of Christ the King were of the view that this special outreach ministry should continue, given the impact it had made in that community

After much thought, prayer and family discussion, Mary and Valda, the daughters of Mrs. Browne, decided to

take on the mantle of carrying on the Friday School. On September 6, 2013 therefore, the Friday School was re-started with the valuable assistance of John (son), granddaughters, Kiana and Sharon and other members of the family circle. Ms. Esther Hurley, a church member, and neighbour, assists as time permits. The generosity, financial and other support of the members of Church of Christ the King have been encouraging.

The Friday School currently has a roll of approximately twenty-five (25) children between the ages of 3-14 years. The school starts around 4:30p.m and lasts until 6.00p.m. The children are encouraged to participate in song, prayer and in the arts and craft activities that relate to the Bible lesson. The lesson plan follows particular themes and during the month of January and February, the children will be learning how to pray using "**The Lord's Prayer**".

The Browne family hopes that this outreach ministry will seek to achieve its objective of "*providing spiritual nourishment to young children in the hope of influencing their lives and possibly the lives of their parents/guardians*".
