Saints Days

St. Matthias, Apostle Matthias first appears in the Acts of the Apostles, where he is chosen by the casting of lots to replace Judas after Judas's betrayal and suicide. His calling as an Apostle is unique as he is the only Apostle not called directly by Jesus. St. Matthias is commemorated this year on February 24th.

St. David, Bishop David was a Welsh bishop during the 6th century who would later become the patron saint of Wales. He was a renowned teacher and preacher who founded several monastic settlements and churches in Wales. St. David is venerated on March 1st.
