The Saints

***Saint Patrick, Bishop** Patrick was a Roman missionary and Bishop in Ireland. He is known as the 'Apostle of Ireland' and is one of the primary patron saints of Ireland. Legend credits Patrick with teaching the Irish about the Holy Trinity using a shamrock and as a result shamrocks are the central symbol of St. Patrick's Day. This year St. Patrick is venerated on March 18th but it is usually celebrated on March 17th.*

***Saint Joseph** According to the New Testament writings, Joseph was the husband of Mary, the mother of Jesus. He only appears in the gospels of Matthew and Luke and he is generally assumed to be deceased by the time Jesus starts his ministry in Cana. St. Joseph is commemorated on March 19th.*

***Saint Cuthbert, Bishop** Cuthbert was an Anglo-Saxon monk, bishop and hermit associated with the monasteries of Melrose and Lindisfarne in the Kingdom of Northumbria. He is considered to be the patron saint of Northern England. Cuthbert is remembered on March 20th.*
