

MINISTRY OF THE WORD

1st Lesson: Isaiah 45:1-7

Youth

READER: A reading from the word of God, written in Isaiah Chapter 45, beginning to read at the 1st verse

Thus says the LORD to his anointed, to Cyrus, whose right hand I have grasped to subdue nations before him and strip kings of their robes, to open doors before him—and the gates shall not be closed: I will go before you and level the mountains, I will break in pieces the doors of bronze and cut through the bars of iron, I will give you the treasures of darkness and riches hidden in secret places, so that you may know that it is I, the LORD, the God of Israel, who call you by your name. READER: A reading from the word of God, written in 1 Thessalonians Chapter 1, beginning to read at the 1st verse.

Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace. We always give thanks to God for all of you and mention you in our prayers, constantly remembering before our God and Father your work of faith and labour of love and steadfastness of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ. For we know, brothers and sisters beloved by God, that he has chosen you, because our message of the gospel came to you not in word only, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction; just as you know what kind of people we proved to be among you for your sake. And you became imitators of us and of the Lord, for in spite of persecution you received the word with joy inspired by the Holy Spirit, so that you became an example to all the believers in Macedonia and in Achaia. For the word of the Lord has sounded forth from you not

only in Macedonia and Achaia, but in every place where your faith in God has become known, so that we have no need to speak about it. For the people of those regions report about us what kind of welcome we had among you, and how you turned to God from idols, to serve a living and true God, and to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead—Jesus, who rescues us from the wrath that is coming.

Saints' Days

St. Simon and St. Jude: St. Simon the Zealot and St. Jude Thaddeus were two of the twelve Apostles of Jesus Christ. Little is recorded about them in the Gospels but early Church tradition indicates that they worked as an evangelistic team in Persia and Armenia. The feast day is celebrated on October 28th.

Alfred the Great : He was the King of Wessex from 871 to 899 and is the only English monarch to be accorded the epithet "the Great". In 878, he successfully defended his nation from Viking invaders and made the defeated survivors accept Christianity. Alfred went on to encourage education and improve his kingdom's legal system and military structure. Alfred died on October 26, 899 and he is commemorated on the anniversary of his death, in the Anglican Communion.
